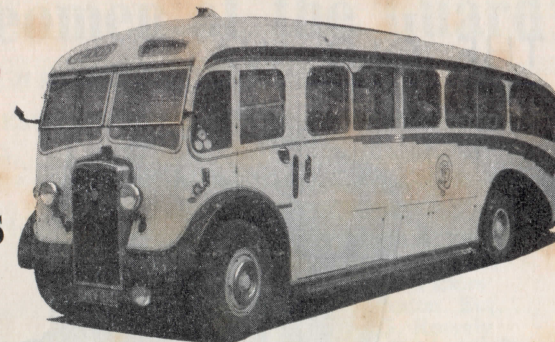

## "The Yeomen of the Guard"

**T**HIS is the one more serious work in the series. Gilbert and Sullivan have deserted satire and they have given us a human and a moving story, improbable in some of its details, but nearer probability than most of the plots.

The music, beautiful at all times, has a wistfulness, a restraint, not to be found in the other operas. The scene is Tower Green, the period is the Tudor period, and the atmosphere is that of old Merrie England.

Jack Point is a strolling player—a merryman of infinite wit—working the fairs in company with Elsie Maynard. For the sake of one hundred crowns he allows the girl to be married blindfold to the condemned Colonel Fairfax. In an hour's time that undaunted soldier of fortune is to be beheaded and she will regain her liberty.

Sergeant Meryll and his daughter Phoebe, meanwhile secure the prisoner's release by surreptitiously obtaining the keys from the dismal jailer, Wilfred Shadbolt.

Jack Point realises too late his own love for Elsie Maynard. The girl has found happiness in the arms of her bridegroom in the strange adventure on Tower Green.

Fate has cheated the jester, and he falls insensible, a tragic figure in motley, from heart-broken grief.
